

## Outlet Maintenance & Safety Checklist

REGULAR INSPECTION	TESTING OUTLETS
Check for loose or damaged outlets.  Look for discoloration or scorch marks.  Ensure outlets are securely fastened to the wall.	Test GFCI outlets monthly.  Use a tester tool to check for correct wiring and grounding.
CHILDPROOFING	UPDATING OUTLETS
<ul><li>Install safety caps on unused outlets.</li><li>Replace standard outlets with tamper-resistant (TR) outlets.</li></ul>	<ul> <li>Upgrade two-prong outlets to three-prong outlets.</li> <li>Install GFCI outlets in areas prone to moisture like bathrooms and kitchens.</li> </ul>
